Where to Find Scholarships

1. Check the <u>Grade 12 Grad Class of 2024 TEAM</u> under the Scholarship Channel for updates and details.



This Grad TEAM is where you will find all of the local and District-based scholarships. Other important grade 12 and Graduation information will be posted on this TEAM as well. Be sure to check it out each time you receive a notification.

Mrs. Albright will continue to post local (in-house/CNHS specific) awards, as well as other new scholarship opportunities. Mrs. Albright's posts will get very busy in April to June, as this is when many of these scholarships become available.

2. Check our <u>District-based scholarship site</u> for many scholarships offered. This scholarship list attempts to capture a selection of community, regional, and national scholarships available to students. The website is a working document and it will be revised and updated on an ongoing basis. Please check for updates frequently. This website is also posted on the CNHS website under the guidance – scholarships tab, under NB scholarships. It is listed on the Grade 12 Grad Class of 2024 TEAM as well. The website is:

- 3. Students are encouraged to search college and university (post-secondary) websites for scholarships associated with specific institutions. Many post-secondary schools have a one-page application form that can be filled out to apply to many scholarships, in addition to separate application forms for larger scholarships. It is important to be aware of this when applying for scholarships at colleges and universities. Pay attention to due dates to apply.
- 4. Some employers and organizations offer scholarships that are specific to them and not advertised through schools each year. Feel free to check with businesses to see if they offer scholarships.
- 5. Parents or students working for some employers may have access these scholarships. For example, Old Dutch and McCain have Scholarships that students can apply for if they have a parent that works there.
- 6. The websites listed below provide additional scholarship and bursary opportunities. Many students at CNHS who receive scholarships have received one from using these scholarships sites to apply. For some of these sites, you will create an online personal file.
